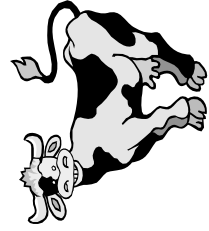

Simply layer your organic matter together, add water, and turn occasionally. Use anything that

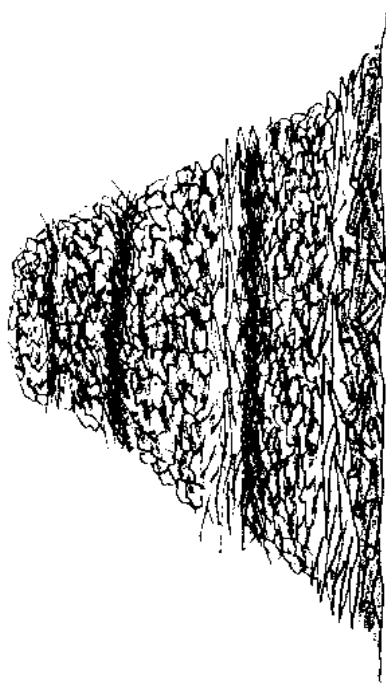
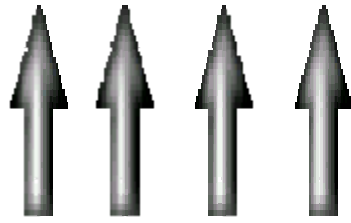
comes from nature:

Animal manure, flowers, etc ...

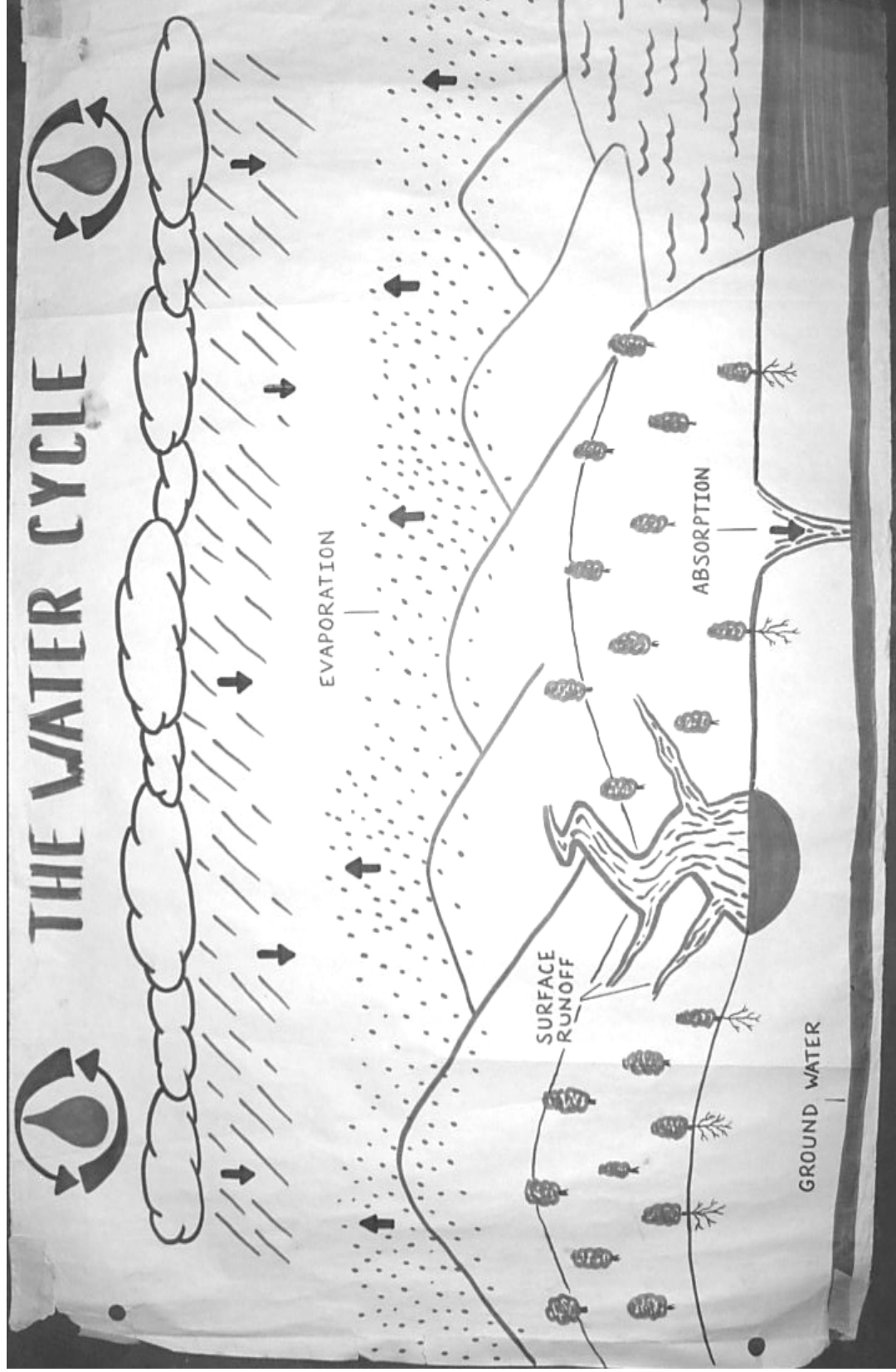
Grass clippings, leaves, kitchen scraps, etc ...

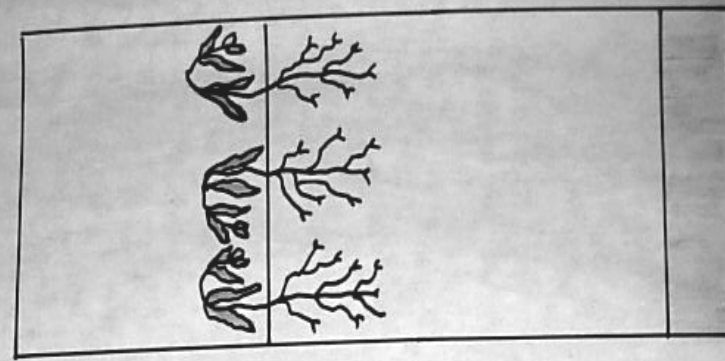
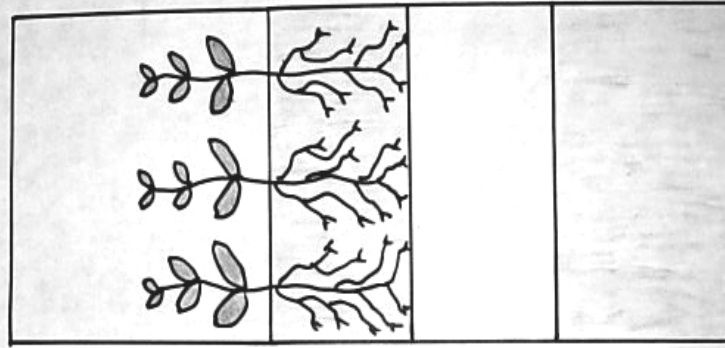
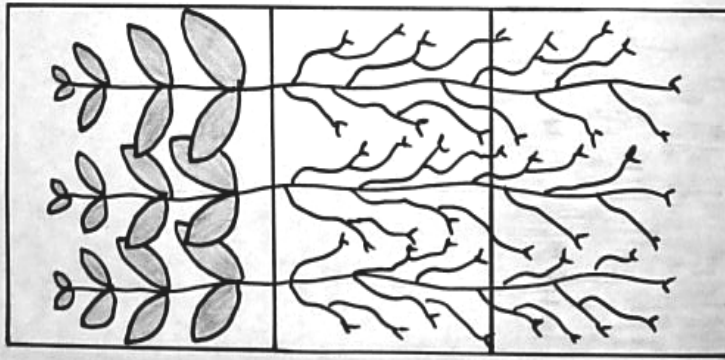
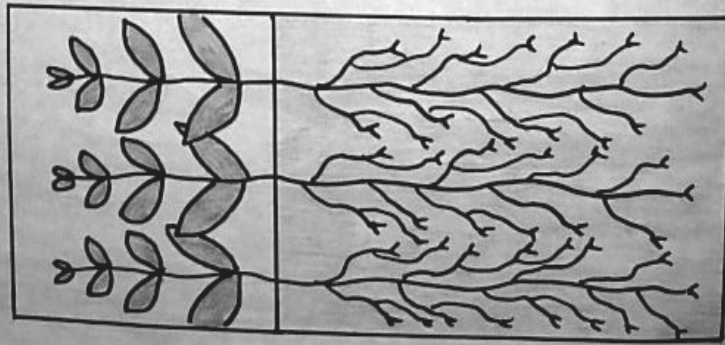
Water Cycle Poster
